Know your Rights

On 17th Aug 2017, a workshop on Right To Information Act (RTI) was organized in Christ the King Community

Centre. Fifty-two children were part of this session. Advocate J.P Gadiya and Advocate Kulkarni, Advocate Swapnil Jagtap

headed this session. Advocate J.P Gadiya sir spoke about General Court Information which included its working &

disciplines, Types of Court. He also stated about RTI, How and when to file RTI, its advantages, and disadvantages.

The key points which I understood about RTI were as follows:

- 1) We have to write application on issues/problem
- 2) Fill up the RTI form as per steps
- 3) Submit the form
- 4) After 30 days we get information about issues /problems. But if the problem is urgent we can get information even within 48 hours (2 days).
- 5) We get information through the means of video, audio, money order or else could be personally collected. It was a very important and informative session.
